SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SALE

The Sale will be conducted subject to the Conditions of Sale Lawrie and Symington Limited, as approved by the Institute of Auctioneers and Appraisers in Scotland which will be on display in the Auctioneer's office on the day of sale. In addition, the following conditions apply.

1. No animal may be sold privately prior to the sale but must be offered for sale through the ring.
2. Animals which fail to reach the price fixed by the Vendor, may be sold by private treaty after the Auction. All such sales, must be passed through the Auctioneers and will be subject to full commission. Reserve Prices should be given in writing to the auctioneer prior to the commencement of the sale and not on the entry form.
3. All stock must be numbered (**lot numbers will be clipped in pens where applicable**) and penned in accordance with the catalogue on arrival at the market.
4. Vendors of Sheep and Cattle will be required, by Declaration incorporated in the official Entry Form to give a Warranty of Soundness in respect of udder for all their entries.
5. Physical defects in sheep, cattle, and horses must be declared on the entry form or to the auctioneer at time of sale.
6. No substitutes to entries will be accepted after closing date as highlighted in letter. Any substitutes brought on the sale day **WILL NOT BE OFFERED FOR SALE.**
7. All lots must be pre-entered in writing or by e-mail to jenna@lawrieandsymington.com by 12noon on date of closing. Catalogues will be available at www.lawrieandsymington.com and on the day of sale.
8. All stock should be accompanied to the sale by the relevant documentation i.e., Passports for Cattle and Licenses for Sheep and Goats. Pigs should not be removed from the premises without an official license (schedule 2).
9. All stock will be sold as unregistered, if no registered number is given on the entry form.
10. Entries will only be accepted on an official entry form, with full payment by the allocated entry closing date (condition 6).
11. Entries should be on the first come, first served basis, allowing for the number of pens available.
12. Entries must be accompanied with correct Movement paperwork.
13. It is now a legal requirement that all sheep born after January, 2010, and sold as breeding sheep must be double tagged with one electronic ID tag.
14. Entry Fees and Declaration – As stated on Consigner/Information Letter / £6.00 per head (£5.00 + VAT = £6.00)
